GOD'S CHOOSING FOR BLESSING

The Lord is the One who chooses for blessing – not birth position, talents, societal rank, etc.

- Abraham
- Isaac over Ishmael
- Jacob over Esau
- Joseph over Reuben because Reuben defiled Jacob's marriage bed
- Ephraim over Manasseh

Don't be upset when God chooses to bless someone else. Notice that in nearly every circumstance, God stayed faithful to His covenant of increase and blessing, but God chose which servants He wished to use in particular ways.

In what generation do you find yourself? Where would you place your family? Where would you gauge society to be? Notice that in each generation it IS possible to encounter the Lord and have a solid relationship with Him, but there is a decline unless we maintain fervor and help future generations encounter the Lord for themselves.

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
